

## **OUTLAW STAMPEDE GROUND RULES**

- The Outlaw Stampede is an open rodeo, and contestants are not required to hold association cards
- General PRCA Rules apply (rule book is available in the office)
- Rodeo Starts at 7:00pm
- Gates open at 6:00pm
- Rodeo Office opens at 6:00pm

### **EVENTS**

- Bareback Riding
- Saddle Bronc Riding
- Bull Riding
- Barrel Racing
- Steer Wrestling
- Team Roping
- Tie-Down Roping
- Break Away Roping
- Junior Bareback Riding – 17 and Under
- Junior Bronc Riding – 17 and Under
- Junior Barrel Racing – 17 and Under
- Junior Bull Riding – 17 and Under
- Junior Steer Riding – 8-12 year old

\* If under the age of 18, participants must have a signed wavier from a parent or guardian in order to compete.

### **ENTRIES**

- Entries are open Wednesday at 6:00pm for the next weeks performance.
- Entries close Monday at 3:00pm the week of the performance.
  - o Entries can be made online or by calling 406-920-3772
  - o Entry office is open from 10:00am-2:00pm Wednesday- Monday
- If contestant turns out, turn outs must be received by 6:00pm or contestant is required to pay fees before entering again.
- Entries are limited to 12 per event per performance
- Entries in junior events are limited to 5 per performance
- If necessary, slack will be held prior to the rodeo from 3:00-5:00pm
- Outlaw Stampede has the right to take late entries if the event is not full by the time entries close.

- Contestants must fill out and sign a release form and W9 prior to competing or riding on the grounds.

### **FEES**

- Fees are \$75 for both rough stock and timed events (\$75 each side for Team Roping).
- Fees are \$25 for Junior events.
- Fees are to be paid in cash to the rodeo secretary before contestants compete.
- Contestants will be given ONE companion pass after fees are paid.
- Stock charge for timed event cattle is \$15

### **PAYOUT**

- \$500 added to each event
- \$250 added to junior events
- Payout
  - o 1-3 contestants; one money
  - o 4-5 contestants; two monies
  - o 6+contestants; four monies (max)

### **DRAW**

- Draw and positions will be done in the afternoon the day of the performance between 12:00pm and 2:00pm by computer.
- Callbacks are between 2:30pm and 5:30pm at 406-920-3772

### **DRESS CODE**

- Contestants entering the arena must have on a long sleeve button up western shirt, hats and boots.

### **STALLS**

- Stalls are available for \$25 per night and must be paid prior to use.
- Stalls must be cleaned out daily

### **POINTS/BUCKLES**

- Buckles will be awarded to the high point earner in each event, and will be presented on the last night of the rodeo series
- Points will be awarded as follows:
  - o 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup>

- 8 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>
- 6 points for 3<sup>rd</sup>
- 4 points for 4<sup>th</sup>
- 1 point for competing each night if contestant did not place
  - In the event of a tie, tie breaker goes to contestant with the most money won
  - Additional tie breakers are up to the discretion of Outlaw Stampede officials

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

- Outlaw Stampede reserves the right to suspend any contestant due to aggressive behavior towards any official, staff member, or patron.
